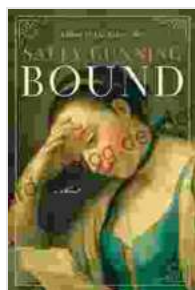

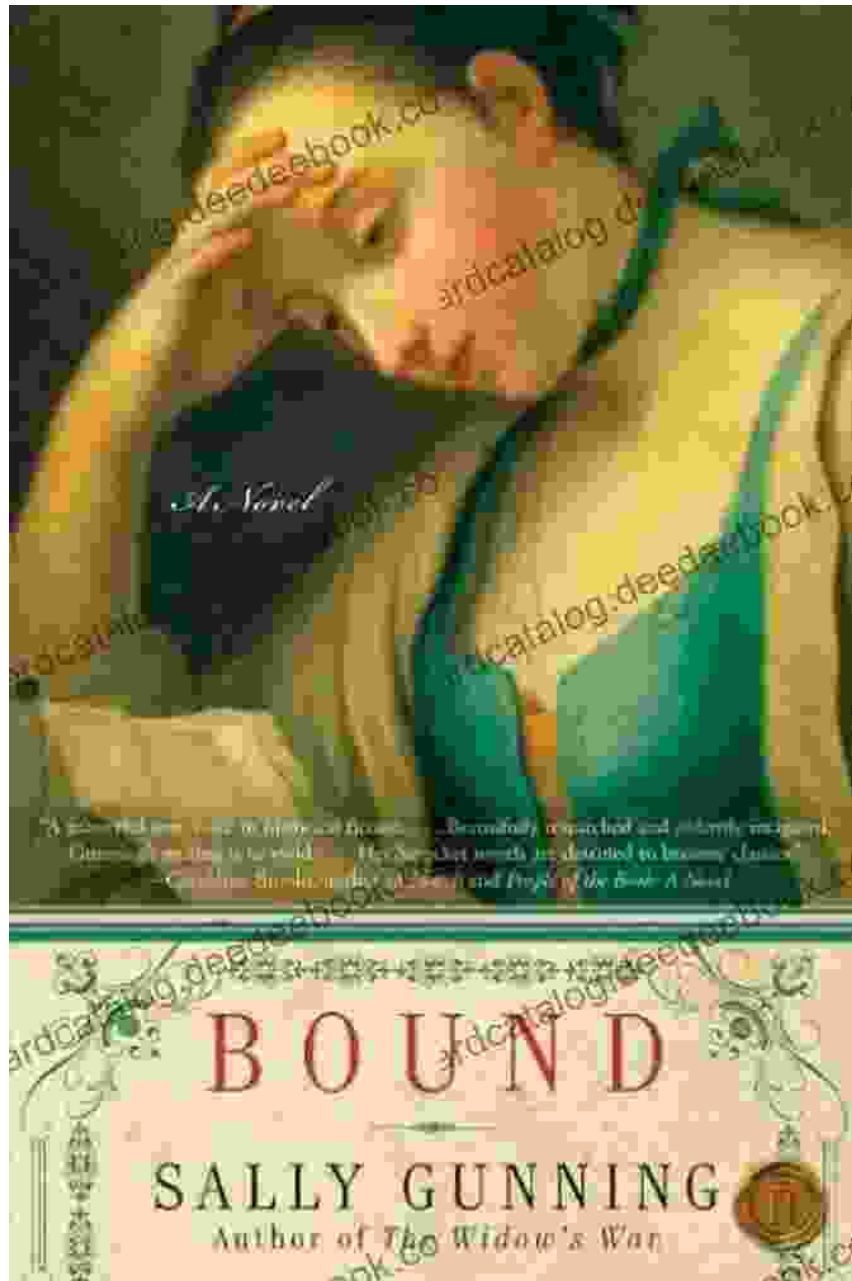

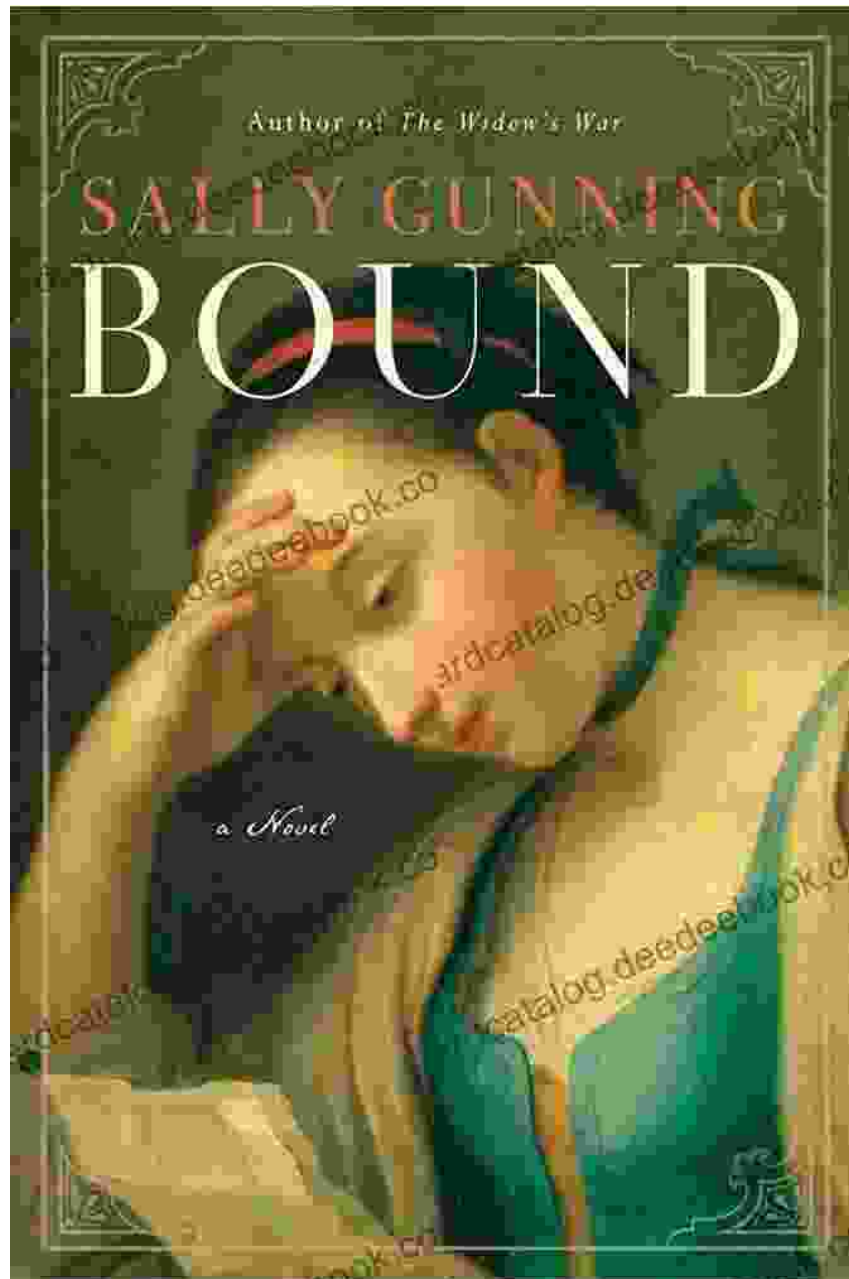
Lily

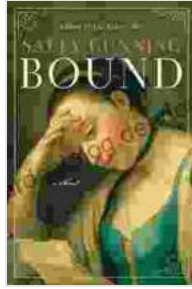

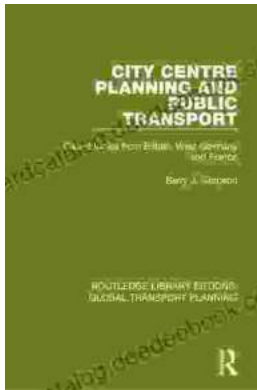

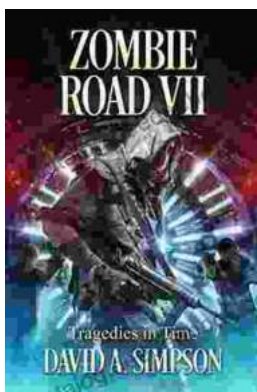
