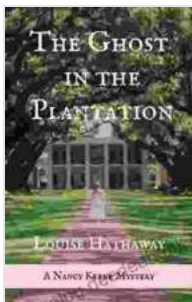


Nancy Keene Mystery: Unraveling the Enigmatic Disappearance of a Promising Student

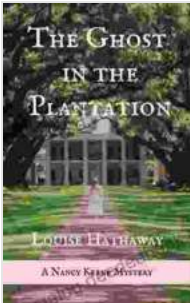
Aftermath and Closure

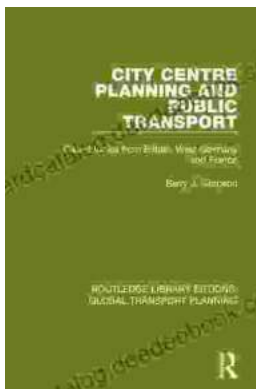
